Your research information will need to include the following topics:

• The impact of colonization on the nominated family group,

• Cultural factors, include any that may influence the delivery of nursing care, - White man affect people - remoteness etc.

• Discuss the dialect used, - Don't talk same - different dialects

• Cultural norms relating to customs, and rituals, - specific to group.

• The main Aboriginal community controlled health service and the services they provide
WAACCHS - internet. Skin groups

• Factors affecting access and the delivery of health care -
